



Our community pool is ready to reopen with some important guidelines to protect pool users and our POA from risks related to COVID-19.

Our pool will reopen, June 12, with hours of 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. for property owners who have completed the required COVID-19 Waiver and returned it to DAMC. The pool complex will be closed on Thursdays for landscape maintenance.

A group of property owners has collaboratively developed the following reopening guidelines.

The MSRPOA Pool Reopening Waiver form and related directions for activation of pool entry cards have been provided to all property owners previously by email. For those that may have missed this, here is the information:

Only property owners who have completed and returned the COVID-19 Waiver form will have their pool access cards activated.

Pool users will notice some new signage at the pool that provides updated guidance for use of public pool facilities such as this. Please pay attention to and abide by the guidelines. These are provided to reduce individual, community and POA risks from COVID-19 infection.

The key guidelines for pool users follow:

- **Property owners assume full responsibility for use of pool facilities regarding exposure and infection with COVID-19.**
- Pool Complex will be closed on Thursdays for landscape maintenance.
- **Only property owners and immediate family members are allowed in the pools.**
- Property owners are required to have a signed and filed COVID-19 Waiver for pool access cards to be active.
- Hand sanitation gel dispensers have been installed at the entry gate, and near bathrooms. Please use these.
- Property owners must provide and use their own pool furniture.
- Please wash hands with provided soap dispensers in bathrooms with each bathroom use.
- No food preparation or picnicking is allowed.
- Use of playground equipment is not allowed.
- Capacity limits for the upper and lower pools are posted at 50%. These may be updated as the COVID pandemic progresses.
- Use safe social distancing – six feet
- Remember you are responsible for your family's safety and the safety of other pool users.
